Today I serve NA by being a sponsor, meeting, and committee representative. This program has had a huge impact on my life as it has taught me a new way to live which I can share with others and lead by example.

I am in my second term at Southern Oregon University and have maintained a 3.7-grade point average. I am an excellent student; I am excited to say that I love school. I chose Southern Oregon University because it is in the same town I live in, and I love to be a part of my community. I have had the best support from Southern Oregon University since I started there. I am planning on getting a bachelor's degree in psychology and possibly continuing on to get a Master's Degree in Social Work or psychology. I have worked in many jobs over the years as a corporate customer service representative and know that I have gained many great communication and organizational skills. I worked as a childcare provider for seven years when my children were young which gave me a more holistic perspective regarding family dynamics and children's needs.
